

# CRRSAA “Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriation Act”: Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF II – second/final disbursement)

Final 10/26/2021

Cameo College of Essential Beauty is a recipient of the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund II (HEERF).

“Under section 314(c)(3) of the CRRSAA, Recipient must make financial aid grants to students (including students exclusively enrolled in distance education), which may be used for any component of the student's cost of attendance or for emergency costs that arise due to coronavirus, such as tuition, food, housing, health care (including mental health care) or child care.”

Per the U.S. Dept of Education the institution has the ability to determine its policy within specific guidelines.

Amount of HEERF to be divided evenly amongst qualified students: **\$147,567**

Cameo College of Essential Beauty will be distributing the HEERF II funds into two disbursements beginning on May 25<sup>th</sup>, 2021 (1<sup>st</sup> Disbursement)

The second disbursement will begin on November 5<sup>th</sup>, 2021

Date of Distribution for the below qualified students: 11/5/2021

A qualified student is defined as:

- \* A student who is currently enrolled as of Oct 19<sup>th</sup> 2021
- \* A student that is deemed eligible for 2021/2022 FAFSA award year
- \* A student that is enrolled in a Title IV Eligible Program (program min. 600 hours)
- \* A student that is in good standing as of 10/29/2021 (meeting Satisfactory Academic Progress “SAP” )

A student that does NOT qualify for HEERF are defined as follows:

- \* A student that was NOT actively enrolled/attending as of Oct 19<sup>th</sup>, 2021
- \* A student that is NOT deemed eligible for 2021/2022 FAFSA
- \* A student that is NOT enrolled in a Title IV Program (program min. 600 hours)
- \* A student that is in NOT good standing (meeting SAP) by 10/29/2021
